

HANDS UP – USER TESTING INFORMATION LEAFLET

About Hands Up:

Hands Up is an interactive installation; the project aims to tell stories in an interesting and unique way. The fantasy/crime fiction story is projected on to a plain wall and a Kinect is set up in front of the children. Children see the story come to life on the screen and participate in certain segments of the story by simply moving in front of the Kinect (e.g. climbing beanstalks).

User Testing:

Our aim is to set up the interactive installation and watch how children will respond to the program.

Initially, we will not communicate with them to see how they will understand the program's features on their own.

We would like to film their responses for development purposes.

After observing their responses we plan to have a brief informal group discussion, discussing their experience and finding out ways to improve the program.
